Ongoing Projects in Flat Bush (As of January 2024)

The FBRRA team has constantly raised local issues with the HLB via meetings and presentations. The major issues raised included the missing footpaths in several sections of the main roads, the lack of a Community Centre and illegal rubbish dumping

The HLB has plans for the following works in Flat Bush:

- 1) Install temporary gravel footpath on Baverstock Road (southern side between Chapel Rd and Baverstock Oaks School).
- 2) Install temporary gravel footpath on Chapel Road (western side between Accent Dr and St Lukes / Sancta Maria).
- 3) Install temporary gravel footpaths on Flat Bush School Road (both north and south sides between Murphy's Rd and Golden Ave).
- 4) Install temporary gravel footpath on Murphy's Road (eastern side between Ormiston and Norwood Dr).
- 5) The HLB proposes a significant capital investment to bring existing assets up to standard including the Wetlands Building in Barry Curtis Park.
- 6) Medvale Avenue Reserve Children's Playing facilities is completed by HLB.

- 7) Auckland Transport is completing the footpath along the western side of Te Irirangi Drive near the intersection of Accent Drive.
- 8) Replacement of the automatic bollards with a double swing arm gate on Chapel Road Carpark in Barry Curtis Park- completed.

9) Renewal of playground in Barry Curtis Park at Stancombe Road – completed.
